ORDER NO: KERC/2025/01

IN THE MATTER OF THE EXCLUSIVITY CLAIM BETWEEN PRADO POWER LIMITED AND HAVEHILL SYNERGY LIMITED IN RESPECT OF OKPO COMMUNITY, DEKINA LGA, KOGI STATE COMMISSION'S ORDER AUTHORIZING PRADO POWER LIMITED TO COMMENCE CONSTRUCTION AND OPERATION OF ITS SOLAR POWER PLANT IN OKPO COMMUNITY

WHEREAS:

1. The Kogi State Electricity Regulatory Commission ("**the Commission**") is empowered under the Kogi State Electricity Law 2024 to regulate electricity generation, distribution, and supply activities within the State.
2. The Commission received claims of exclusivity from **Havehill Synergy Limited** and **Prado Power Limited** over the same project area located within **Okpo Community, Dekina Local Government Area** of Kogi State.
3. Following a series of meetings, reviews, and document verifications, the Commission observed that **Prado Power Limited's exclusivity arrangement predates that of Havehill Synergy Limited** and is supported by prior correspondences and engagement records held by the Commission.
4. The Commission, having carefully examined all available records, correspondence, and representations made by both parties, has resolved the matter in accordance with due regulatory process.

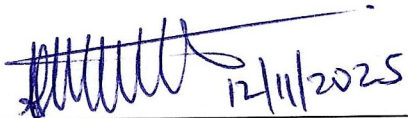
NOW THEREFORE, THE COMMISSION HEREBY ORDERS AS FOLLOWS:

1. That the exclusivity claim of **Prado Power Limited** over the Okpo Community is hereby recognized as valid and authentic.
2. That Prado Power Limited is authorized to commence construction and subsequent operation of its solar power plant and associated distribution infrastructure within the Okpo Community project area.
3. That **Havehill Synergy Limited** shall refrain from undertaking any activity, engagement, or development within the said project area, pending any further directive of the Commission.

4. That **Prado Power Limited** shall ensure compliance with all applicable technical, safety, and environmental standards, and shall submit periodic progress and compliance reports to the Commission.
5. That this Order takes immediate effect and shall remain in force until duly amended or revoked by the Commission.
